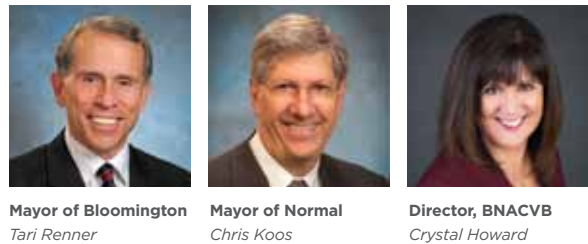

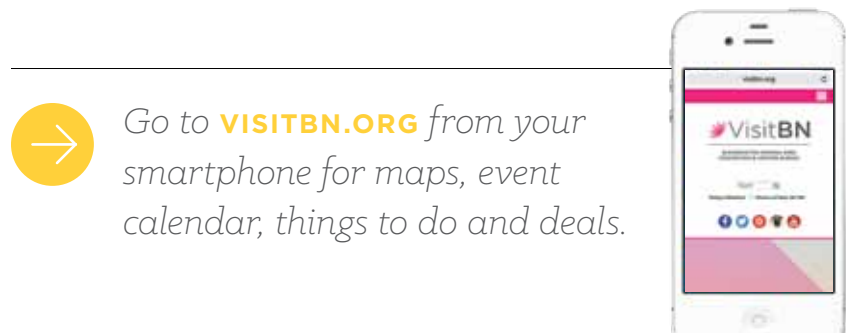

sweet to the last drop

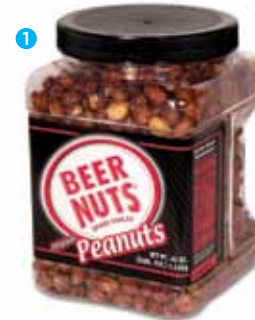

During the golden era of Route 66, Funks Grove depended on the steady flow of travelers that visited their store. It still remains a popular attraction for Route 66 travelers today. Guided tours of the grounds are offered during the sirup-making season, which is typically the end of February through the middle of March.

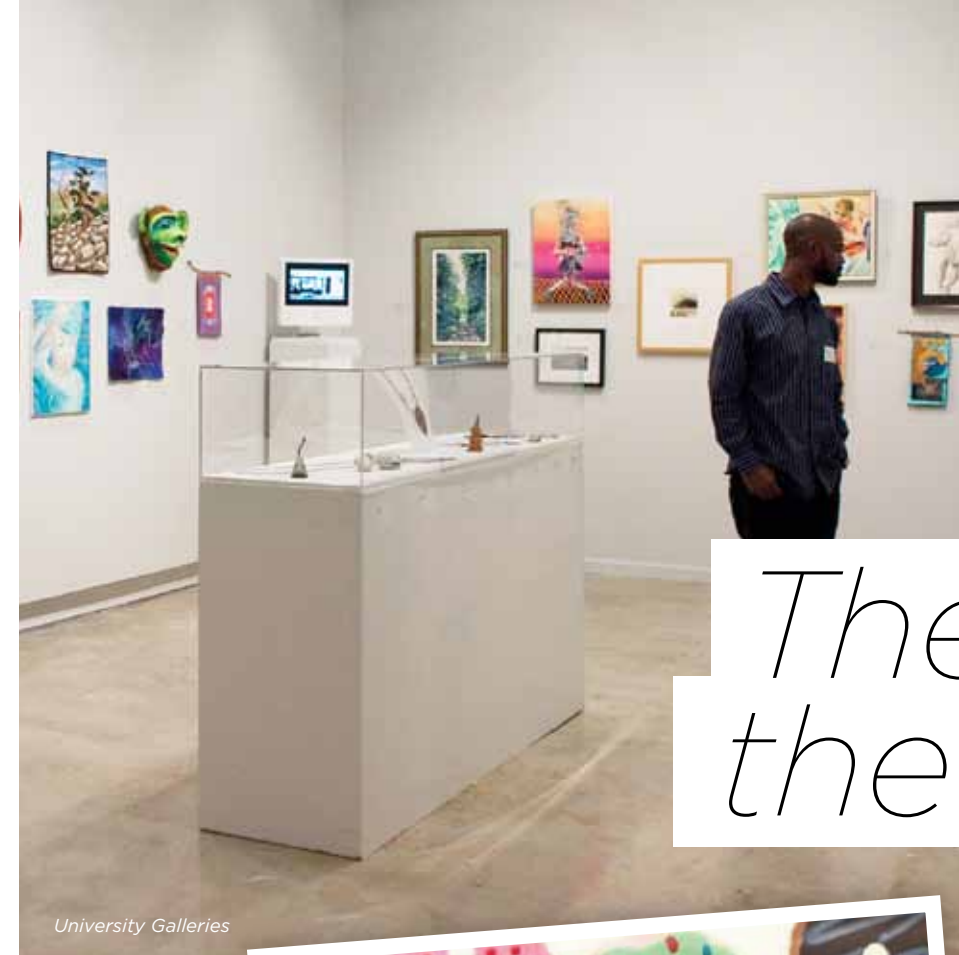
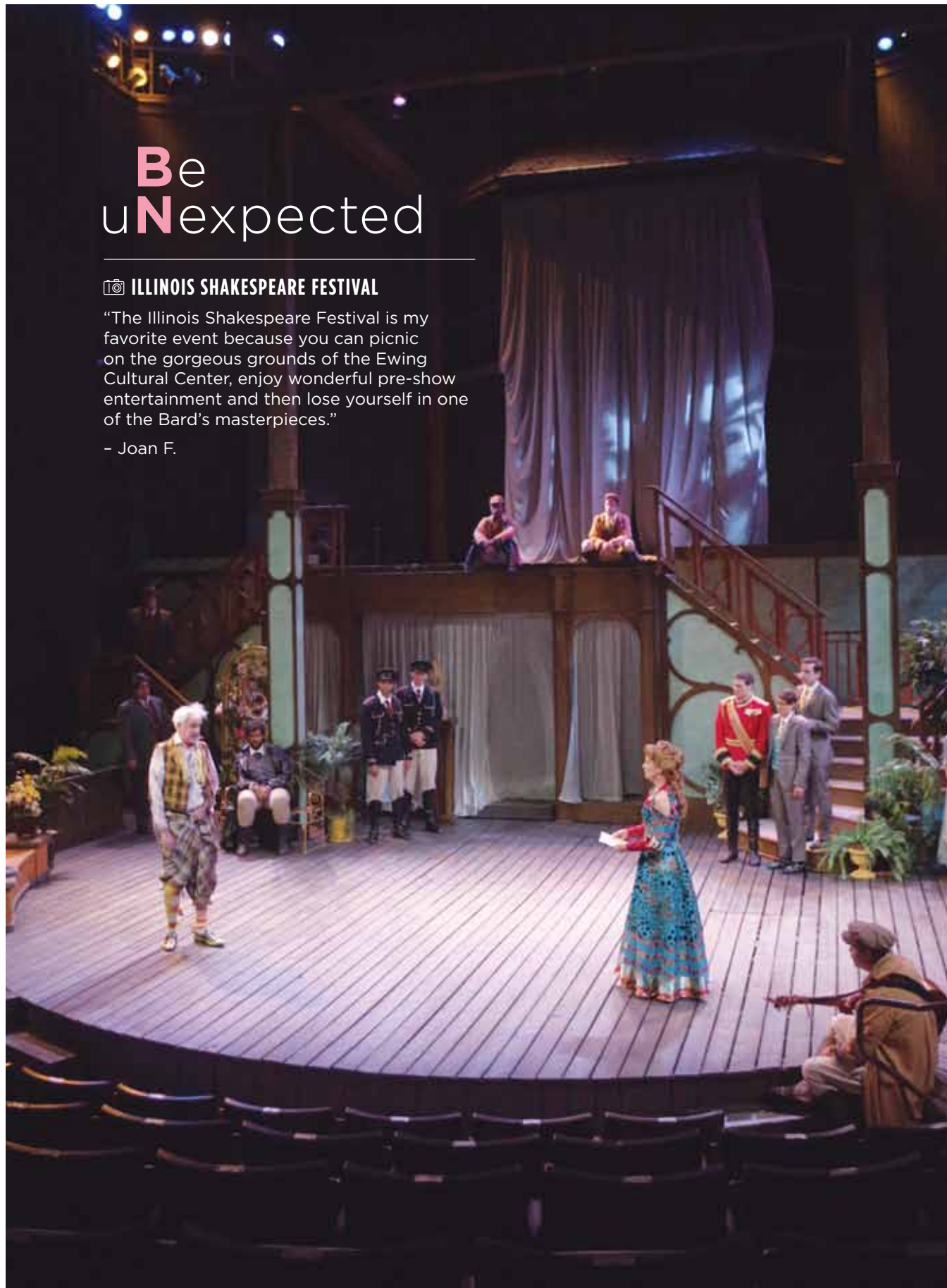
- 1 BEER NUTS INC.** In 1937, Edward Shirk founded Beer Nuts, which produces different types of nuts covered with a sweet and salty glaze. Bloomington is still the only city in the world to make this product, and they now ship to all 50 states, even some foreign countries.
- 2 ILLINOIS STATE UNIVERSITY** Founded in 1857, Illinois State University is the oldest public university in the state. Among its original supporters were David Davis and Jesse Fell, whose friend, Abraham Lincoln, was the attorney hired by the Board of Education to draw up legal documents to secure the school's funding.
- 3 STEAK 'N SHAKE** Can you imagine a world without hamburgers? We can't. And thanks to Gus Belt, we don't have to. He opened the first Steak 'n Shake in Normal in 1934. Today, people in 32 states can enjoy their chili, hamburgers and milkshakes.
- 4 ROPP JERSEY CHEESE FARM** What started out as a self-sustaining family farm has grown into a seventh generation dynasty. Ropp Jersey Cheese Farm produces cheese curds as well as artisan cheddars, colbys and many others. It also sells meat products, including pork, beef and poultry.
- 5 OVER THE RAINBOW** Dorothy Gage was born in Bloomington and died in infancy. Her uncle, Author L. Frank Baum, in an effort to console his wife gave the protagonist of his new novel, *The Wonderful Wizard of Oz*, the name Dorothy Gale. She is buried at Evergreen Memorial Cemetery.
- 6 AVANTI'S ITALIAN RESTAURANT** You don't need to travel across the pond to try some classic Italian food. Avanti's has been serving Italian dishes to the BN community since it was founded here in 1971. It's most famous menu item is the gondola: ham, salami, cheese and lettuce served on fresh baked bread. Buon Appetito!
- 7 ADLAI STEVENSON** BN has quite the presidential history. Adlai Stevenson moved to Bloomington with his family in 1852. He attended Illinois Wesleyan University and founded the *Bloomington Daily Bulletin*. He was elected to the United States House of Representatives and served from 1875-1877. He served as vice president under Grover Cleveland from 1893-1897. He is buried at Evergreen Memorial Cemetery.
- 8 THE LOST SPEECH** Known as the "lost speech" because it was so captivating that reporters forgot to take notes, Abraham Lincoln spoke out against the Kansas-Nebraska Act in the since-destroyed Major's Hall on the corner of Front and East Streets in Downtown Bloomington. This speech catapulted him as the leader of the Illinois Republican Party.
- 9 STATE FARM INSURANCE** State Farm Insurance has been a good neighbor to Bloomington-Normal, which is where it was founded in 1922. BN continues to serve as its headquarters. With 14,109 employees, it's BN's largest employer. Nationwide, it has approximately 65,000 employees and 18,000 agents.

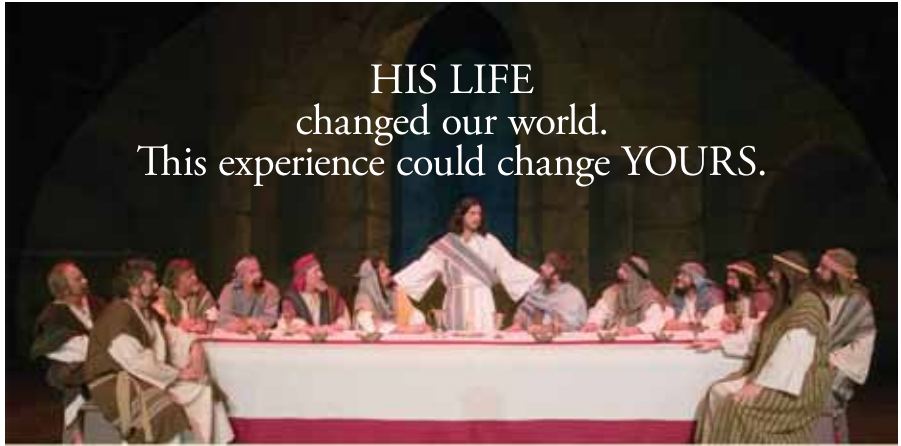

There are 11 historical and 13 major attractions that sit on Historic Route 66 in Bloomington-Normal. Our newest addition is the Cruisin' with Lincoln on 66 Visitors Center.

Route 66 isn't the only chapter in BN's history book. History buffs will love taking a tour of the David Davis Mansion, a 19th century mid-Victorian style home that served as the home of Supreme Court Justice David Davis. Tours can also be taken at Ewing Manor, the former estate of Spencer and Hazle Ewing that was completed in 1929. The manor and its gardens embody the grace and natural beauty of its Channel-Norman style.

A day full of history is not complete without a trip to a museum. The Children's Discovery Museum has three floors of hands on play activities that will inspire kids' love of learning. The McLean County Museum of History has 18,000 objects in its collections and offers hands-on activities and educational programs for children.

“A GEOGRAPHICAL JOURNEY” PARKWAY

Towanda, IL

The Parkway is a 1.6 mile stretch of Route 66 with educational kiosks. The walking tour has fliers printed in several languages and a collection of Burma Shave signs.

CASEY'S GARDEN SHOP

1505 North Main Street, Bloomington, IL

Originally a market that helped feed locals and Route 66 travelers, this family business is now a full-service florist and garden center that has served the surrounding area since 1949. Casey's was inducted into the Illinois Route 66 Hall of Fame on June 12, 1999.

DEAD MAN'S CURVE

Towanda, IL

A dangerous curve on the original Route 66 before the 1940's, this curve caught travelers off guard as they misjudged its sharpness and narrow width. Many accidents were caused by travelers speeding on the unfamiliar road.

DIXIE TRUCK STOP

501 South Main Street, McLean, IL

In 1928, J.P. Walters and John Geske rented part of a mechanic's garage to sell sandwiches to Route 66 travelers. By the 1930's, the operation had grown to a full-fledged restaurant with cabins and a cattle pen. The stop, which is the oldest truck stop in America, still serves travelers along Route 66 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

FORREST PARK

1813 Springfield Road, Bloomington, IL

One of the area's most popular tourist camps during the early 1920s, Route 66 tourists would use this location as a rest-area and campground. No longer a lodging zone, it is now a city park populated with mature oak and hickory trees, a playground and four shelters.

FUNKS GROVE PURE MAPLE SIRUP

5257 Historic U.S. 66, Shirley, IL

This business was dependant on the steady stream of customers that Route 66 brought to its door. Today, the sirup farm at Funks Grove remains a favorite stop among Route 66 travelers. On the land, you can also find the historic Funks Grove Cemetery.

QUINN SHELL STATION

802 North Main Street, Bloomington, IL

The Quinn family owned and operated this full-service gas station for more than 70 years. The station was inducted into the Illinois Route 66 Hall of Fame on June 9, 2012, just a few years before the Quinns retired. Closed today, it remains a drive-by attraction with original memorabilia displayed in the windows.

SPRAGUE'S SUPER SERVICE STATION / RYBURN PLACE

305 East Pine Street, Normal

This Tudor-Revival style building was built in 1931 to service traveler needs on Route 66. It housed a café, gas station and garage. The building has been approved by the Illinois Preservation Agency and is on the National Register of Historic Places.
