

# Route 66 Red Carpet Corridor Festival - Bloomington

## Event Policies

For the safety and enjoyment of everyone attending **Route 66 Red Carpet Corridor Festival**, the following rules are in place:

### All ages are welcome

### Seating

The area in front of the performance stage is designated as a standing/dancing zone. This area is first come, first served. Attendees are permitted and encouraged to bring their own chairs and blankets to view the live music.

### Parking Information

Lincoln Deck (southwest corner of Front Street & East Street): 800 parking spaces are available for free unlimited parking on Saturdays.

### Pets

Pets are allowed onsite. All pets must be on a leash at all times. Anyone bringing an animal to Route 66 Red Carpet Corridor Festival will be responsible for and liable for any damage or injury caused by the animal.

### Service Animals

Under the Americans with Disabilities Act, the definition of “service animal” is limited to a dog that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for an individual with a disability who is in attendance. The task(s) performed by the dog must be directly related to the person’s disability. Under the ADA, “comfort,” “therapy,” or “emotional support animals” do not meet the definition of a service animal. – U.S. Dept. of Justice. If you have a certified service animal that you are required to have with you at all times, you’ll be required to have your service animal with you and ON LEASH at all times. Under the ADA, service animals must be harnessed, leashed, or tethered, unless these devices interfere with the service animal’s work or the individual’s disability prevents using these devices.

### Behavior

- The following are strictly prohibited:
  - Fighting, taunting, threatening behavior, disorderly or disruptive behavior, verbal abuse, foul or disruptive language, obscene gestures, racial or ethnic slurs, groping, sexual assault, or unwanted sexual remarks
  - Weapons of any kind (Includes guns, ammunition, pocket knives, pepper spray, etc.)
  - Fireworks or explosives
  - Illegal substances
- Any individuals or groups found in violation of this policy may be removed from the festival. If you feel you’ve been harassed, or feel unsafe, please visit our Information Booth, or contact an event staff member.

### Weather

- The festival is a rain or shine event.
- In case of inclement weather, please seek shelter inside a local business or Lincoln Parking Deck.
- If there is thunder or lightning, festival activities will temporarily be paused.

**Alcohol**

- YOU MUST BE 21 YEARS OF AGE to consume alcohol within the festival site. ID'S WILL BE CHECKED.
- No outside alcoholic beverages will be allowed onsite; there will be alcoholic beverages available for purchase in the beer tent.
- Over intoxication or signs of impairment related to excessive alcohol consumption are not allowed.

**Food/Coolers**

- We encourage festival attendees to support our local food vendors.
- Vending will only be allowed by registered vendors in the designated vending areas.
- No unapproved vending including the sale or re-sale of alcoholic beverages is permitted on festival grounds.

**Safety and Security**

- Event staff and volunteers are on duty throughout the entire event, and are charged with making sure the event runs smoothly. Your cooperation with them is greatly appreciated. Please report any incident to the event staff.
- In the event of an emergency, please listen to and follow the directions of the event staff.
- Festival attendees are expected to exercise common sense and avoid unnecessary risks.
- Stay hydrated! Take breaks from the sun! Wear a hat, and reapply sunscreen often.

**Notice of Filming and Photography**

When you enter, photography, audio, and video recording may occur. By entering the event premises, you consent to being photographed for event promotional materials.

**Smoking/Vaping**

Smoking is not allowed within the festival grounds. Those wishing to smoke are asked to move to an area outside the festival grounds. Please extinguish and deposit your butts in the trash, not on the street or sidewalks.

**Trash**

Please dispose of all litter and recycling in the appropriate receptacles.

**Lost Child Procedure**
